WINE DESCRIPTION

The Mazoyeres Chambertin vineyard is a soft slope at 840 feet. It produces grapes of great finesse.

TASTING NOTES

Dark color. Very intense aromas of red or black fruits with gammy notes of musk and fur, often licorice when the wine has aged a bit. Round, full bodied, complex with well integrated acidity. Long warm finish with refined tannins. A concentrated and seductive wine.
