Demain (Tomorrow) is the namesake of Two Hands. Demain reminds us that the best vintage is always the next. The hands on the label belong to owner & winemaker Arnaldo Dimani and symbolize knowledge and work ethics.

TASTING NOTES

Bright, intense ruby color with purple hue this wine shows a developed fruity bouquet mixing floral notes (violets) and ripe fruit. In the mouth, supple and long, you find black fruits, licorice and violets with expressive tannins.
